To fill me with Combats: fear of not having all the answers Proverbs 9:10, NIV – The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. Psalm 111:10, NLT – Fear of the Lord is the foundation of true wisdom. All who obey his commandments will grow in wisdom.
To lengthen Combats: fear of an untimely death Proverbs 10:27, NIV – The fear of the Lord adds length to life, but the years of the wicked are cut short.
To provide me Combats: fear of impending doom Proverbs 19:23, NLT – Fear of the Lord leads to life, bringing security and protection from harm.
To help me Combats: fear of making mistakes Proverbs 16:6b, NLT – By fearing the Lord, people avoid evil.
To show me Combats: fear of unforgiveness Luke 1:50, NLT – He shows mercy from generation to generation to all who fear him.
A relationship with himself – Combats: fear of being alone Psalm 25:14, NIV – The Lord confides in those who fear him; he makes his covenant known to them.
To fill me with Combats: fear of being unhappy in life Psalm 128:1-2, NLT – How joyful are those who fear the Lord—all who follow his ways! You will enjoy the fruit of your labor. How joyful and prosperous you will be!
To provide national Combats: fear of national disaster Isaiah 33:6, GNT – [God gives] stability to the nation. He always protects his people and gives them wisdom and knowledge. Their greatest treasure is their reverence for the Lord.
To use me to others - Combats: fear of not being helpful to others 2 Samuel 23:3-4, NIV – The God of Israel spoke, the Rock of Israel said to me: "When one rules over people in righteousness, when he rules in the fear of God, he is like the light of morning at sunrise on a cloudless morning, like the brightness after rain that brings grass from the earth."
To give me a Combats: fear of a hopeless future Proverbs 23:17-18, GW – Don't be envious of sinful people; let reverence for the Lord be the concern of your life. If it is, you have a bright future. James 1:12, NLT – God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.
