1. Temptation comes from
James 1:13-14, NLT – And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "God is tempting me." God is never tempted to do wrong, and he never tempts anyone else. Temptation comes from our own (broken/corrupt) desires, which entice us and drag us away.
Deuteronomy 17:17a, NIV – "[The king] must not take many wives, or his heart will be led astray.
