Romans 5:3-4, NLT – We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation.

Hebrews 5:8, NLT – Even though Jesus was God's Son, he learned obedience from the things he suffered.

Romans 8:17, NLT – And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering.

Hebrews 12:7-8, NLT – As you endure this divine discipline, remember that God is treating you as his own children. Who ever heard of a child who is never disciplined by [his] father? 8 If God doesn't discipline you as he does all of his children, it means that you are illegitimate and are not really his children at all.

Psalm 119:71-72, CEV – When you corrected me, it did me good because it taught me to study your laws. I would rather obey you than to have a thousand pieces of silver and gold.

Hebrews 12:11, NLT – No discipline is enjoyable while it is happening—it's painful! But afterward there will be a peaceful harvest of right living for those who are trained in this way.

yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you

Psalm 119:50, NIV – My comfort in my suffering is this: Your promise preserves my life.

1 Peter 5:10, NCV – In his kindness God called you to share in his eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus. So after you have suffered a little while, he will restore, support, and strengthen you, and he will place you on a firm foundation.

Lamentations 3:33, GNT – [God] takes no pleasure in causing us grief or pain.

6. Through pain, God

What might God be doing through your pain? We don't always know (at least, not yet; see John 13:7 above). But we do know *God is always good*. Rest assured that God has a plan for your pain, whatever it may be. Giving it to him means salvation, healing, help, hope, growth, guidance, renewal, and reward. He loves you with an everlasting love.
